Salomon Storm the Trent

May 15-16, 2010

We'll be returning to our 2-day race format at [Golden Beach Resort](#) to accommodate even more racers in 2010, with the "Trek" and "Trek Elite" events scheduled for Saturday, and the beginner-friendly "Hike" course to take place on the Sunday. Registration is scheduled to open in early December - don't forget that this race was completely sold out by mid-March this year!

Emergency Services Adventure Race (ESAR)

June 19, 2010

The eighth annual edition of the Emergency Services Adventure Race will be staged on all-new ground in 2010, and will feature both the regular ESAR as well as the more compact "ESAR-Lite" racecourses staged from one amazing new host site!

Saucony RockstAR

July 24, 2010

Year 3 of this awesome new race concept will be even bigger and better in 2010, and with the unbelievable 400% increase in registration we saw this year, you'll definitely want to sign up early so that you don't miss out!

September 18, 2010

Canada's first and only relay-style adventure race, hosted at the base of the magnificent Niagara Escarpment. If you liked the course adjustments we made in 2009, just *wait* to see what we've got in the works for next year!

It's going to be an epic "East meets West" race through the City of Hamilton from the Redhill Valley along the Niagara Escarpment through to the Dundas Valley. Teams of three can expect lots of climbing, tough route choices, and some gnarly running (with surprisingly few roads) through the "Raid" (about 25km) and "Enduro" (about 10km) course options. TEAM ATP SALOMON AT THE WORLD CHAMPS

One of these two teams is ATP Salomon, made up of local racers **Andrew Cameron, Leanne Mueller, Scott Pleban** and **Sean Roper** (Scott is actually American, but we've bestowed honorary Canadian status upon him for this race). The team will be faced with up to 900km of racecourse over a 6-day period, passing through trekking, mountain biking, inline skating, paddling and ropes sections throughout the Estoril Coast region of Portugal. Each team will be equipped with a GPS unit that will enable the ARWC website to provide live tracking throughout the duration the race, which will feature 58 teams from 26 countries across the globe!
